Generally speaking, we expect to make decisions concerning courses in June for Winter or Fall courses; in September for Spring courses; and in April for Summer courses. Applications will be retained for twelve (12) months. Persons who submit applications and CVs will receive emailed job postings for specific positions for the subsequent twelve (12) months.
